

Sunrise Sick Call

Starting March 5, 2007

Announcing new limited urgent care service for established HFFM patients.

No more spending time on the telephone seeking an appointment for an acute illness that struck you or your child during the night or early morning. As a patient of HFFM we want to see you first thing in the morning so you can make those decisions about going to school or work, and perhaps avoid taking the whole day off.

Monday through Saturday

- No phone call or appointment needed
- Walk-in urgent care service 8am – 9am
- Must be an established patient of HFFM
- Patients are seen on a first come first serve basis

Appropriate use of Sunrise Sick Call

- Acute illness only – such as
 - Strep throat
 - Upper respiratory illness
 - Asthma flare up
 - Acute rash or swelling
 - Fever
 - Earache
 - Possible pink eye
 - Stomach ache
 - Flu like symptoms
- For established HFFM patients only – new patients must call for a scheduled clinic appoint
- Not for physical exams, chronic medication refills, chronic medical problem check ups, or symptoms that have been going on for weeks or months.
