




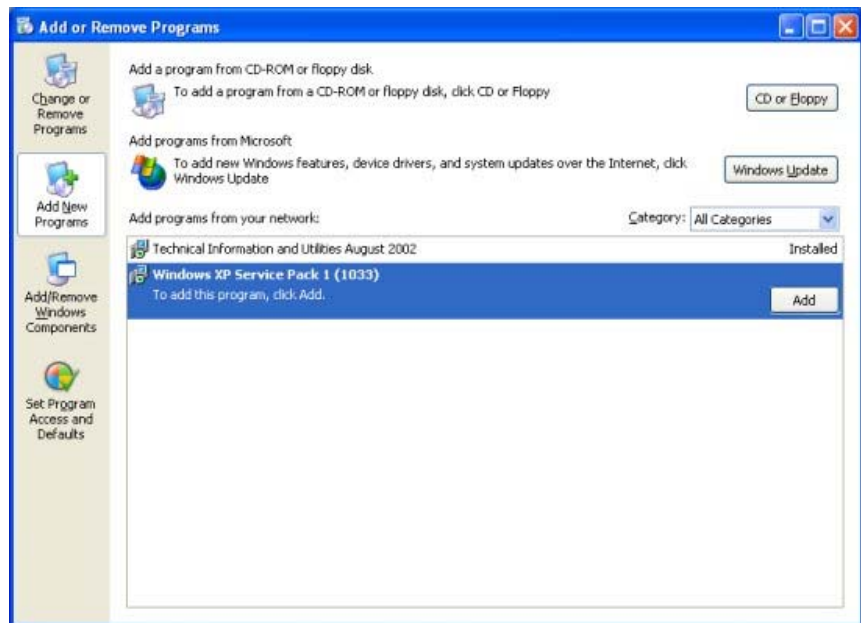
Installing Service Pack 1 for Windows XP on your Computer

Make sure you are connected to the HSC network within the Health Sciences Center via a wired connection. Do not attempt this update via a dial-up connection, or via a wireless connection.

Click on the  Button, then click on .

When the Control Panel windows opens, double click on the icon titled  Add or Remove Programs.

From the left hand panel of the Add or Remove Programs window, select "Add New Programs", you will see the "Windows XP Service Pack 1 (1033)" listed in the right hand panel, highlight it and click the "Add" button, the Windows XP Service pack Setup Wizard will start.

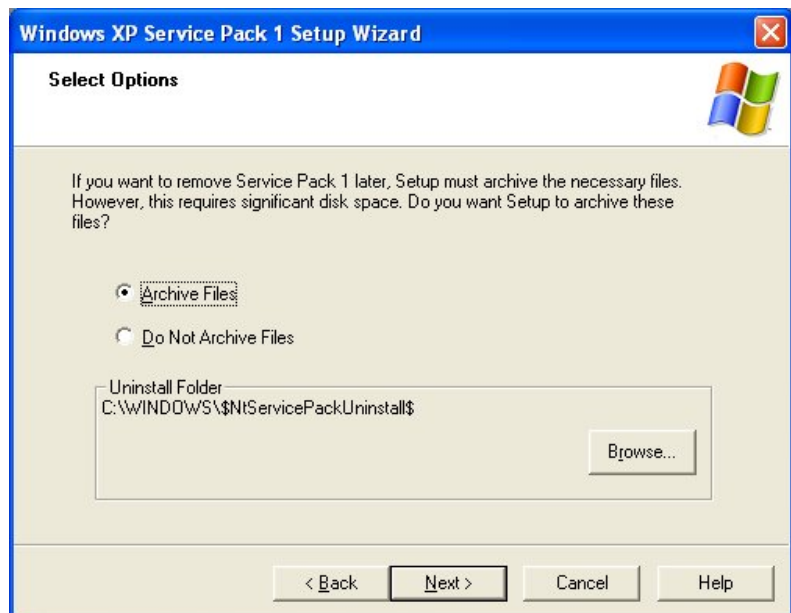


Click "Next" on the first screen.

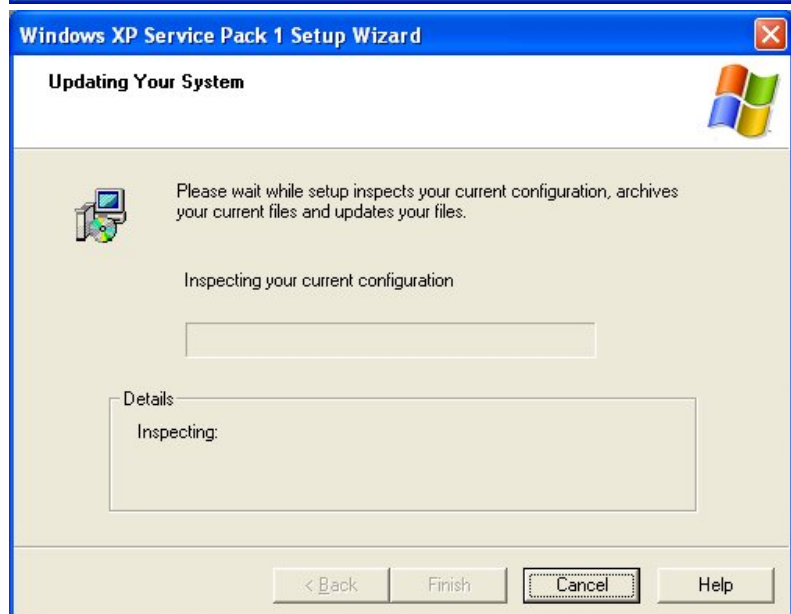


Read the License Agreement and select "I Agree" then click "Next".

On the next screen select "Archive Files" (This will allow you to roll back the installation in case of a failure), then click the "Next" button.



The wizard will inspect your system, check for necessary space, backup files, and install the service pack (this will take some time).



When the install finishes you will be prompted to click the "Finish" button, your computer will then reboot to complete the installation.
