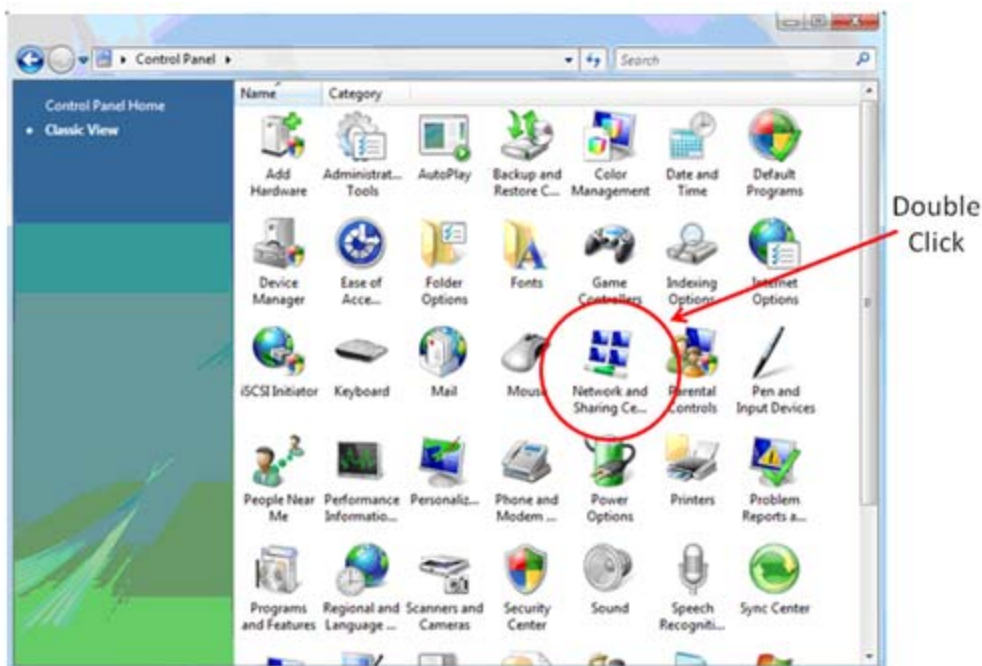
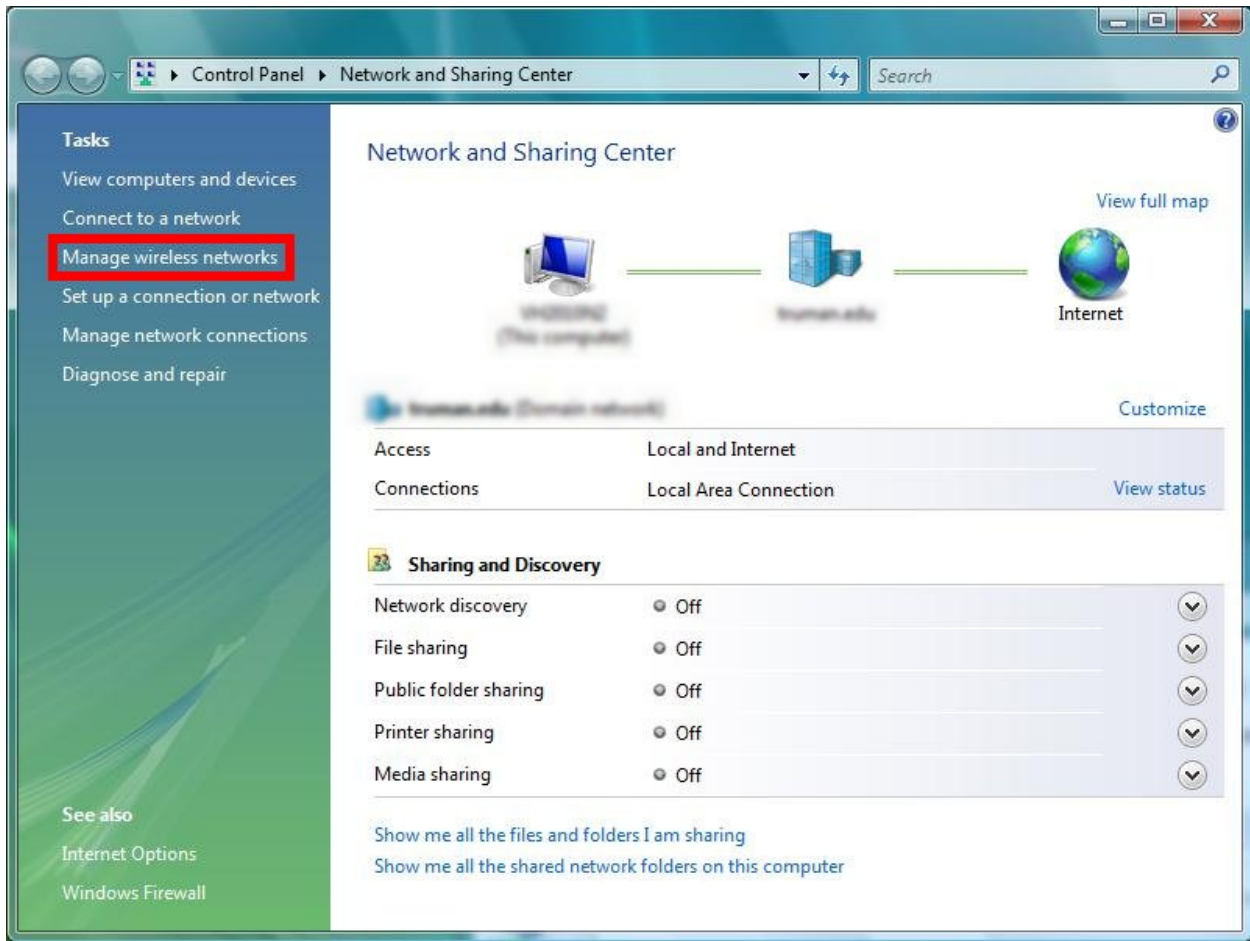


If you are a Windows Vista user please follow these steps to connect to WVU.Encrypted:

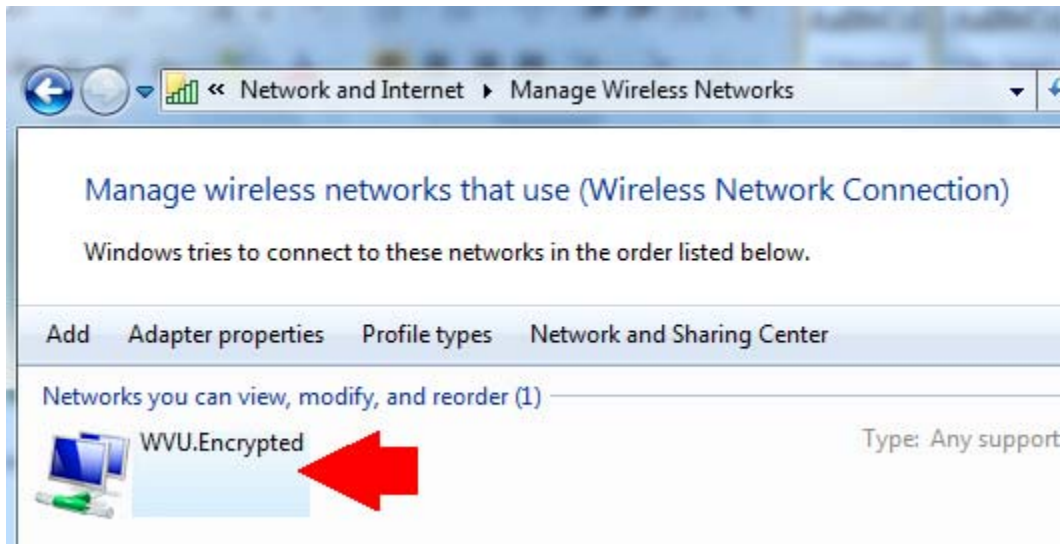
- Run “Windows Update” to make sure you are updated to the latest Windows components.
- Connect to WVU.Encrypted, which will require you to enter your masterid and password.
- Once connected, you will get a Windows Security Alert stating that the ipsCA Global CA Root certificate is a valid certificate but is not trusted in the WVU.Encrypted profile.
- Click Terminate on the alert and we will configure WVU.Encrypted for the valid certificate.
- Go to your Control Panel and double click “Network and Sharing Center”



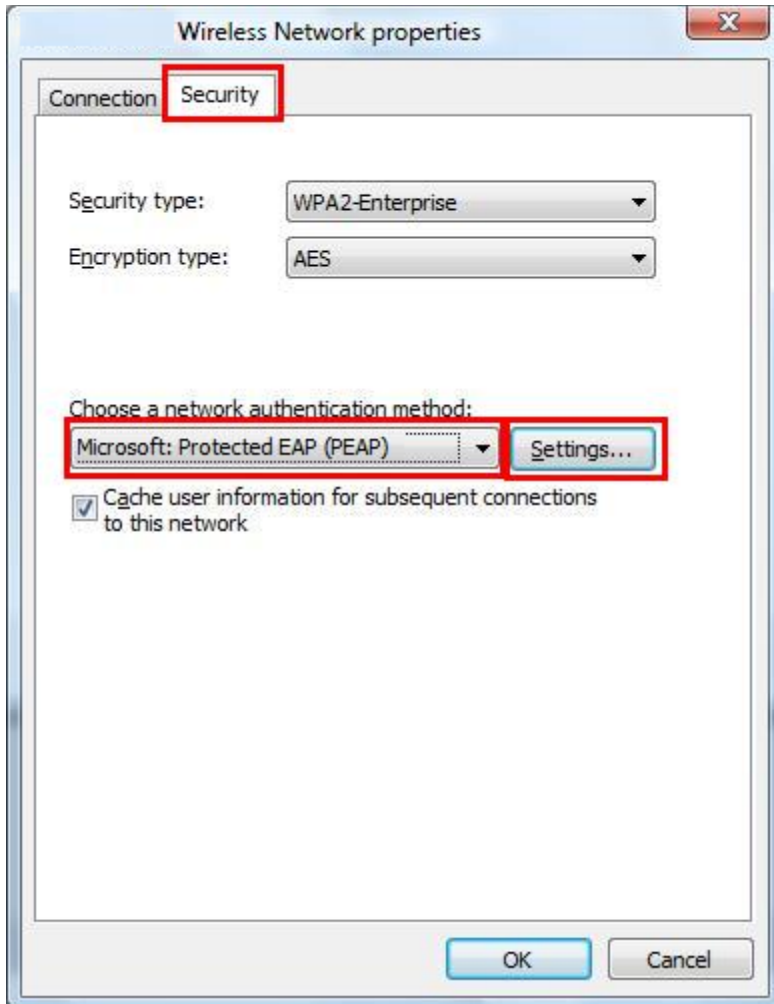
- Click Manage wireless networks



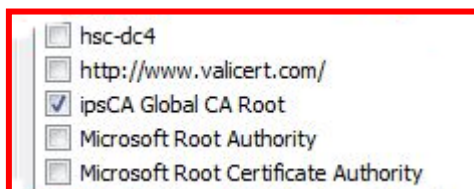
- Select WVU.Encrypted, RIGHT click and go to Properties



- Click the "Security" tab



- Under “Choose a network authentication method”, click “Settings”
- Under “Trusted Root Certification Authorities” do the following:
 - Uncheck “IPS Servidores”
- Check “ipsCA Global CA Root”



- Click OK
- Click OK again
