Sport Discus Full-Text is a unique resource for both practical and research literature on sport, physical fitness and physical education topics. Records cover sports medicine, exercise psychology, biomechanics, psychology, training, coaching, physical education and fitness, and other sport- and fitness-related topics. This database contains over 600,000 records with journal and monograph coverage going back to 1800. The content also consists of multi-disciplinary, international references from journal and magazine articles, books, book chapters, and conference proceedings. *SPORTDiscus with Full Text* is the world's most comprehensive source of full text for sports & sports medicine journals, providing full text for more than 350 journals indexed in *SPORTDiscus*. Of those, 208 are not found with full text in any version of *Academic Search*, *Health Source* or *Biomedical Reference Collection*. This authoritative file contains full text for many of the most used journals in the *SPORTDiscus* index - with no embargo. With full-text coverage dating back to 1985, *SPORTDiscus with Full Text* is the definitive research tool for all areas of sports & sports medicine literature.

Access via Internet

- Any computer connected to the World Wide Web can access Sport Discus.

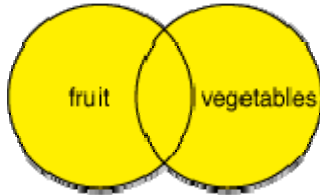
Combining Search Terms

Often research topics are not limited to one topic but combine multiple topics. You need to understand how the program combines topics.

and is the intersection of two sets or topics (these topics are usually different).



or is the union of two sets or topics (they are often synonyms or similar topics)



You may enter one or more terms (e.g., vitamin c common cold) in the query box and press the enter key or click the Search button. Sport Discus automatically combines (ands) significant terms together.

Searching

Type a word or phrase in the Find area. Examples of the types of searches you can enter are listed below in italics:

Term: *running*
Phrase: *beta blockers*

If you are using advanced search, set other limits as needed. You may want to limit to Full Text (whole article is available). You may want to limit years published, for example 1993 to 2007. Also consider limiting Language to English and Publication type to Journal Article. Select the Search Button. Sport Discus performs the search and indicates how many records it finds for your search.

Truncation

Truncation is a method to look for plural, singular, and various forms of a word. For example, typing the word swim with an asterisk, swim* will search for any word that begins with this prefix, i.e. swim, swimmer, and swimming. If you need internal truncation, the question mark is used. For example wom?n retrieves records on woman or women.

Refining a Search

Search results can be improved by: 1) limiting search to title (TI Article_ Title) or 2) looking at the full article description and clicking on the key words. Sport Discus provides a consistent methodology to retrieve information that may use different terminology for the same concepts. Terms within the key word field are the most relevant to your topic and can be used as hyperlinks to refine search.

Abstract: The purpose of this study was to compare exercise during dry-land bicycle ergometry and **running** in water with a flotation device in individuals with rheumatoid **arthritis**. Eight individuals with adult-onset rheumatoid **arthritis**, between the ages of 30 and 40 years (mean = 35.88, SD = 2.85), participated. Each subject did a graded maximal exercise test on a stationary bicycle and in the water wearing a flotation device, while oxygen uptake (VO₂), heart rate (HR), pain, rating of perceived exertion (RPE), minute ventilation (VE), respiration rate, tidal volume (VT), and respiratory exchange ratio (R) were monitored. Higher maximum RPE and R were seen during water **running**, whereas higher VE and VT were seen during bicycle riding. Heart rate, R, and plateauing VO₂ data indicated that a true physiological peak VO₂ was reached during the bicycle test. Peak VO₂ and HR were similar for either water or bicycle exercise. These findings show that with both forms of exercise, subjects were able to reach training levels as set by the American College of Sports Medicine. The water exercise, therefore, provides a means of exercising for individuals with rheumatoid **arthritis**. It allows them to reach the needed training levels in a comfortable aquatic environment.
