COURSE DESCRIPTION

This conference is designed to address the wide range of clinical findings associated with the care of patients with spinal conditions, including the history and physical exam, spine imaging, treatment of cervical/lumbar pain and operative indications, non-surgical treatment options, and advances in medication treatment of spine pain. Lecture format and case presentations will provide the attendee with take-home strategies for the improved evaluation and treatment of patients with these conditions.
