General Water Outages Affecting Single Office or Classroom Building

That Do Not Contain Special Sanitation/Water Need Operations Such As Food Services, Medical Services, or Child Care Operations

OUTAGES GREATER THAN ONE (1) DAY

As information is available, all occupants, to include students taking classes in this facility, must be notified in advance of the water outage by signage at locations such as building entrances, water fountains, and toilet facilities. Additionally, information must be provided regarding the availability, if any, of alternative toilets and water fountains in nearby buildings. Occupants with special needs must be given alternative work and/or study options as conditions require.

During the outage signage must be maintained at each building entrance, toilet facility, and water fountain stating that facilities are out of order and the location of the closest toilet facilities and drinking water supplies.

A temporary drinking water supply must be provided for all occupants on each floor. Temporary drinking water may either be supplied from commercially bottled water or a sanitary food grade beverage dispenser provided with disposable cups and a waste receptacle.
