#### Wooden Stairs

• Stephanie Graham-Sims forwarded a request to Roads and Grounds regarding the wooden stairs near the construction of the Intermodal Facility. Attention on the stairs is needed not only on days with snow, but also on days with frost. There have been reports of the stairs being slick on days where the temps are below freezing.

#### • Parking Concerns and Issues

- Lt. Hill informed the Committee that the Ruby parking garage between the Emergency Room and the Cancer Center is no longer available to WVU HSC clinic patients It is open to Cancer Center patients only. Without the garage, parking is very limited; causing patients to park where they can find space, sometimes in the roadway. It has been necessary to create on-street parking on particularly busy days. Lot 84 has safety issues due to its size. In this lot there is not enough space for a byway and having parking on either side. It can cause potential hazards to pedestrians. Lt. Hill recommends safety checks of the parking lots and opening the garage up to all patients.
- Fire Alarm
  - Room 3603-A is unable to hear the "All Clean" message following a fire alarm. Jeff Kerns said that he would look into this situation and have it repaired.
- Dentistry
  - The department is still preparing for the upcoming re-accreditation. Unused equipment and furniture are being surplused. Due to the large amount of inventory and lack of storage space, private offsite storage is being utilized.

## • OLAR

- Fit testing for the OLAR staff has recently been completed.
- BRNI is opening within the next few weeks. Temperature issues are being addressed in a few rooms.
- Water maze location and issues are being evaluated.

### • HSC Loading Dock
