Demographics


Issues to Consider:

- The greatest population growth was among persons ages 50-64 with the next greatest among those ages 65+.
- Over the ten year period, median household incomes grew by more than \$10,000 in Jefferson and Berkeley counties but remained fairly static in Morgan County.
- The percentage of children living in poverty nearly doubled.

Health Status

Diabetes - in 2012, 31.5% of War Memorial's inpatient discharges were among persons with diabetes. Of the 2012 diabetes-related inpatient discharges at War Memorial Hospital, 15.7% were due to uncontrolled diabetes and 28.1% were due to long-term complications of the disease. The ageadjusted percent of Morgan County adults who had been diagnosed with diabetes was 11% in both 2005 and 2009. 18

Environmental Factors

Radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer in the United States and the number one cause of lung cancer among non-smokers. The average indoor radon level is estimated to be about 1.3 pCi/L (picocuries per liter), and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has established that the "action level" for deciding when you need to "do something" about radon is 4 pCi/L.34
