The greatest population growth was among persons ages 50 -64.


There are significant health disparities, including rates of obesity and chronic illness among the African American and Hispanic populations.

Diabetes

In 2011, 36.4% of City Hospital's Ambulatory Care Sensitive discharges were among persons with diabetes. Of these discharges, 53% were uncontrolled diabetes and 22.8% were long-term complication of diabetes.

In 2011, almost 29% of newborn discharges from WVUH-East's City Hospital had "other significant problems." This category includes a range of conditions ranging from neonatal jaundice to significant problems²⁵.

Environmental Factors

Radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer in the United States and the number one cause of lung cancer among non-smokers. The average indoor radon level is estimated to be about 1.3 pCi/L (picocuries per liter), and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has established that the "action level" for deciding when you need to "do something" about radon is 4 pCi/L.²⁶

Cancer

From 2005-2009, Berkeley County's overall cancer rate and lung cancer rate were higher than the national rate but lower than the state rate. While cancer death rates in Berkeley County are above that national rate, they are falling, with the exception of lung and bronchus cancer among females which is above the U.S. rate and rising.²⁸
