Our Vision

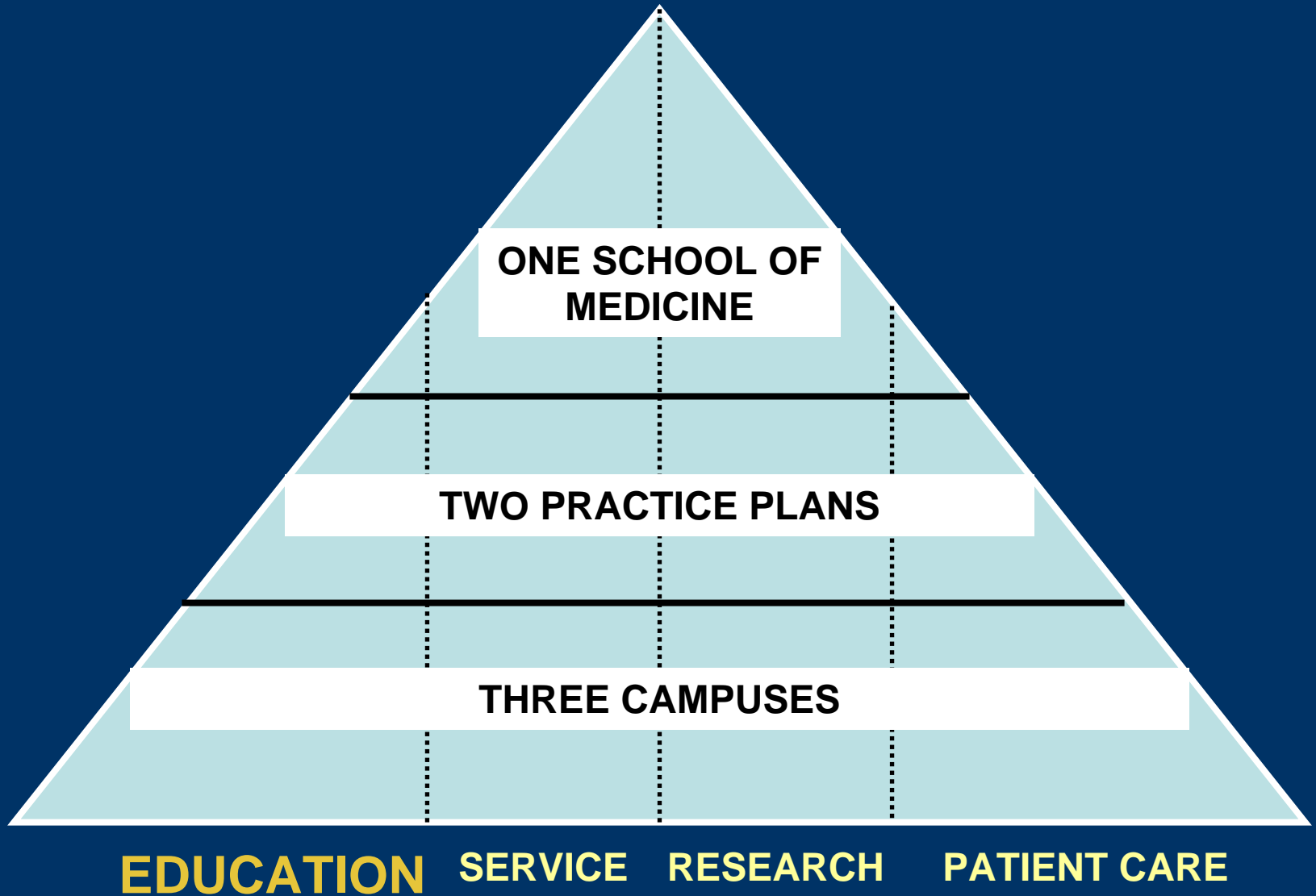

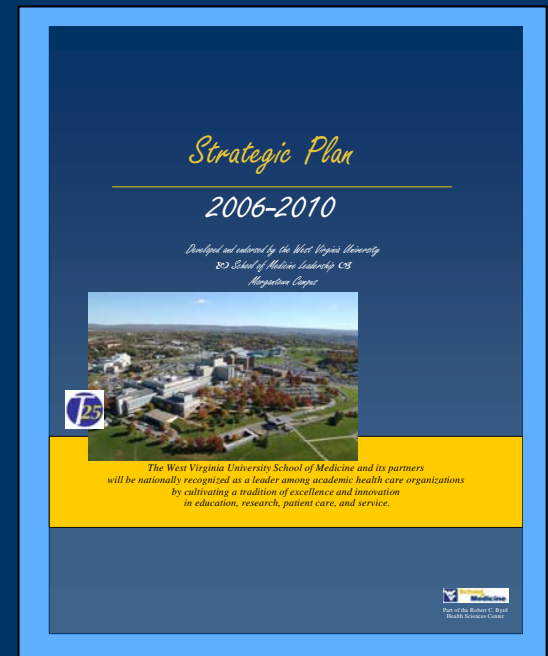

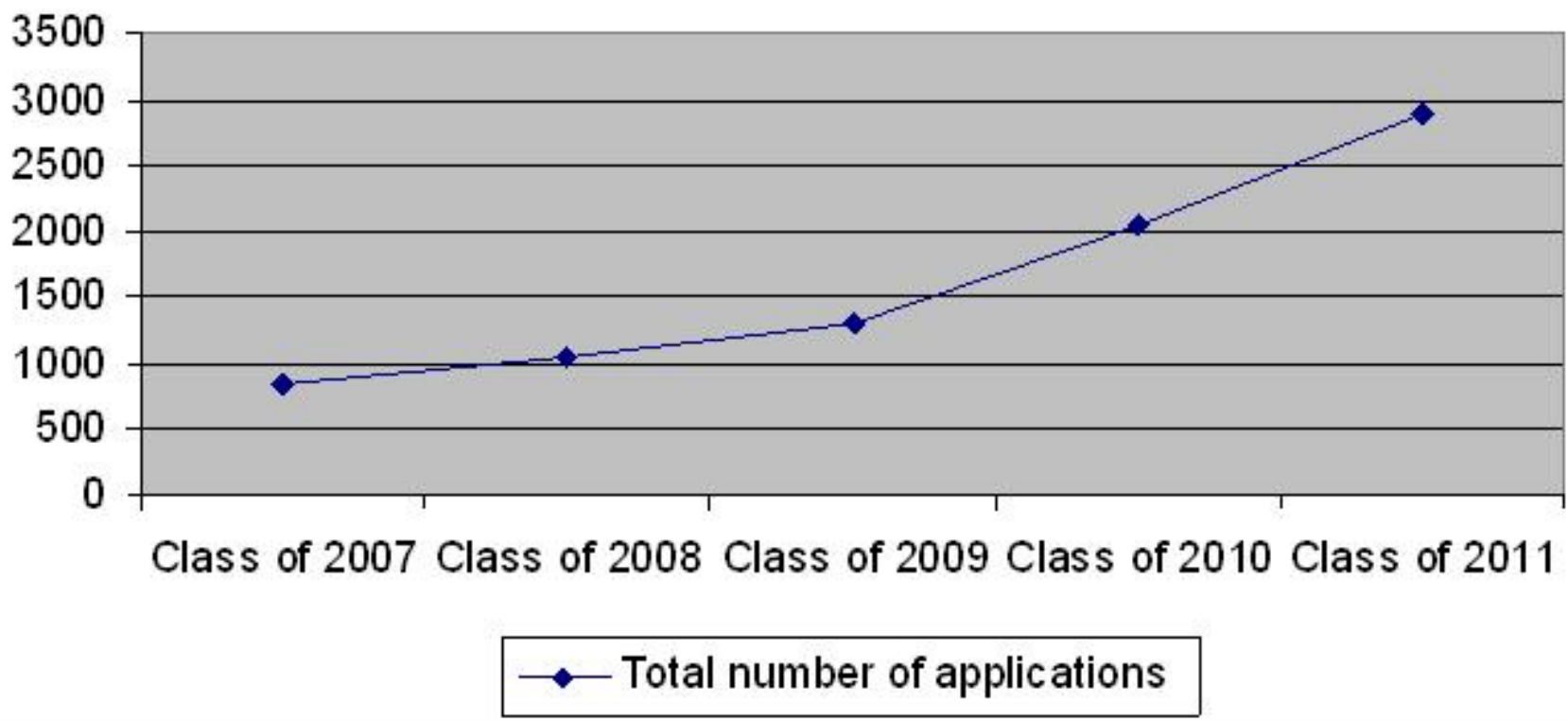
Education Goals

Recruit and retain faculty, staff, residents, and students with strong credentials

- 10% increase in WV resident applicants -- NO
- 10% increase in all applicants 😊
- 5% or less re-cycle rate for academic performance -- NO
- 10% increase in LCME graduates in residency programs 😊
- 10% increase in offers accepted – too soon to know

Education Goals

Create strong academic, clinical and research departments

- Achieve full accreditation of all GME programs – not until after October 2007
- Increase funding for GME from WVUH – under consultant review
- Achieve full accreditation from LCME – final report pending
- Maintain USMLE pass rates great than national average -- 😊

Challenges

- Hiring faculty in Professional Programs
- Clinical Program Development – Prof Programs
- Teaching basic science classes
- Technology/availability of classrooms
- Withdraw rate of accepted applicants for Medical School
- Funding for GME
- Projected requests for new resident/fellow positions will reach 100 over the next five years
- Rising tuition for medical students and professional programs
