**Hunger and Homelessness in Washington DC**

**Course Title:** Hunger and Homelessness

**Course Location:** Washington DC

**Course Description**

The course will examine hunger and homeless in the USA, including current efforts to address and the general shortcomings of eliminating the issue. Central to the carefully designed curriculum is an academic intensive experience in Washington DC over spring break week. Students will serve in soup kitchens, food distribution centers and/or homeless shelters in Washington DC for approximately 15 hours.

**Academic Details**

One academic credit awarded through West Virginia University:

- Service-Learning: Global Service-Learning (SRVL 293) - 1 credit

**Program Timeline** (dates approximated)

<b>March 1 - 24</b>	2 class meetings and academic preparatory work
<b>March 24 - 31</b>	Intercultural Service-Learning in Washington DC
<b>April 1 - 15</b>	2 class meetings and academic completion of course

**Program Tuition:** \$660 / \$560\*
