**The McNair Scholars Program** is funded through the federal Department of Education, and named after NASA astronaut Ronald E. McNair, who lost his life in the tragic explosion of the Space Shuttle Challenger on January 28, 1986. A physicist who earned a Ph.D. at MIT, Dr. McNair placed high value on education, artistic and scientific pursuits, and athletics. The Ronald E. McNair Post-Baccalaureate Achievement Program was established by an act of the U.S. Congress in his memory to support the dreams of Americans like Dr. McNair, those of minority backgrounds and first-generation college students.
