The graduate students in the Department of Pharmaceutical and Pharmacological Sciences at West Virginia University are pleased to announce the 40th Graduate Student Symposium in Medicinal Chemistry to be held June 10-12, 2007 at West Virginia. This meeting provides an ideal setting for graduate students to present and discuss details of their research, in both oral and poster formats, and to develop effective communication skills needed for a successful career in science. Abstracts are invited from graduate students, postdoctoral fellows, and faculty from the departments of medicinal chemistry, pharmacognosy, or pharmaceutical sciences at the Universities of New York at Buffalo, Purdue, West Virginia, Duquesne, Wayne State, and Toledo.

The deadline for Abstract submission is May 31, 2007.

Student oral presentations will take place both Monday and Tuesday mornings. The poster presentation session and career fair will be held Monday afternoon, June 11. The meeting will end on Tuesday, June 12, after presentations by invited speakers.

Abstract Guidelines:

1. Abstracts will be restricted to a 250 word limit, not including title and author information.
2. Abstracts must be typed single space in Times New Roman (12 pt) and fit on one side of an 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper, including relevant figures.

NOTE: Abstracts will be printed in black and white only.

Be sure all figures are clear when printed in grayscale.

3. Margins of 1.5" must be used on all sides.
4. Follow the given example (below) for title and author information. Make sure to underline the presenter's name and provide an email address for contact information.

1. Oral presentations should be no more than 15 minutes in length, with an additional 5 minutes for a question/answer session.
2. We encourage all participants to make their presentation as MS PowerPoint slides.
NOTE: For those using Mac format, you should convert your files to PC format before arrival. We will not have a Mac laptop or adapter available.
3. A microphone will be available for your use. Personal laser pointers should be brought with you, though one may be available.
