

Transfer Students

Pre-pharmacy: Students currently enrolled in a pre-pharmacy curriculum who wish to transfer to WVU to complete their pre-pharmacy training are governed by the general Transfer Student policies and procedures that may be found at <http://www.wvu.edu/FutureStudents/TransferStudents/index.html> .

Professional Program: Students currently enrolled in a Doctor of Pharmacy degree program who wish to transfer into the WVU Doctor of Pharmacy program under Advanced Standing must meet the following criteria in order to be considered for admission:

1. Have met all the entrance requirements and satisfactorily completed all WVU School of Pharmacy prerequisite course work and satisfactorily completed or will complete all pharmacy school work in progress prior to matriculation. A satisfactory performance in the completion of such work is defined as one that is consistent with the student's previous academic record and must include no grades of D or lower in prerequisite courses. Failure to do so will result in revocation of the acceptance by the Admissions Committee.
2. Have at least a 2.5 (on a 4-point scale) professional course work GPA . Grades of D in professional courses cannot be transferred.
3. Be eligible for continuation toward a degree in pharmacy at the school initially/currently attended (be in good academic and professional standing at the school initially/currently attended).
4. Students may transfer only from Schools accredited by ACPE.

Students will only be admitted for advanced standing if space is available in the class for which they would qualify.

Students meeting all the above noted qualifications must :

1. Request an Application for Advanced Standing Transfer from the WVU School of Pharmacy. To obtain an application, please contact West Virginia University School of Pharmacy, Office of Student Services, PO Box 9500, Morgantown, WV 26506-9500.
2. Successfully complete a personal interview.
