Instructions for the Global Health Summit Poster Session

Friday, October 11, 2019

Registration for the poster session will begin at 8:00am in front of Fukushima Auditorium. After registration, you may check your board assignment number to hang your poster. There will be a continental breakfast available to all participants, so you will have time to eat as well as view the other posters before judging begins and/or attend the morning sessions of the Global Health Summit. Judging will begin promptly at 11:00AM. The poster session will end around 12:00pm just before the luncheon keynote address.

The poster boards will be located in the hallway between Fukushima Auditorium and Learning Center Commons (the "Pylons" area) at the Health Sciences Center. You will receive your board assignment prior to the session via email.

Posters should be 36 inches x36 inches (3ft by 3ft), no larger. Please note this specific size is mandatory as there will be two posters to each board.

Fabric posters are welcome. If you are interested in printing your poster on fabric, please use the vendor PosterPresentations in Mountaineer Marketplace.

Students are expected to describe the studies represented in their poster to the judges in a manner similar to that used for oral presentations (Hypothesis or purpose of studies, methods, results, conclusions, and potential implications to human health). Students will be asked to remain at their posters during the scheduled judging.

Judging for posters will be based on:

- The scientific approach used in examining the research topics;
- Clarity and quality of delivery
- Effectiveness of graphics and visual aids
- An understanding of the research subject
- Individual role in project
- Responding to questions

Please review the poster session scoring rubric to prepare.

Submissions will be grouped into categories, and awards for each category will be announced at the closing session of the Global Health Summit at 3pm in Fukushima Auditorium.
