

PARTICIPANTS=12043, MEAN=4.58, STANDARD DEVIATION=0.77


1st PERCENTILE=2.80, MEDIAN=4.60, 99th PERCENTILE=6.20

Reader's Guide to Understanding This Information:

Approximately 75% of female participants and 80% of male participants < 20 years of age had normal serum phosphorus levels. A higher proportion of females compared to males had depressed phosphorus levels.
