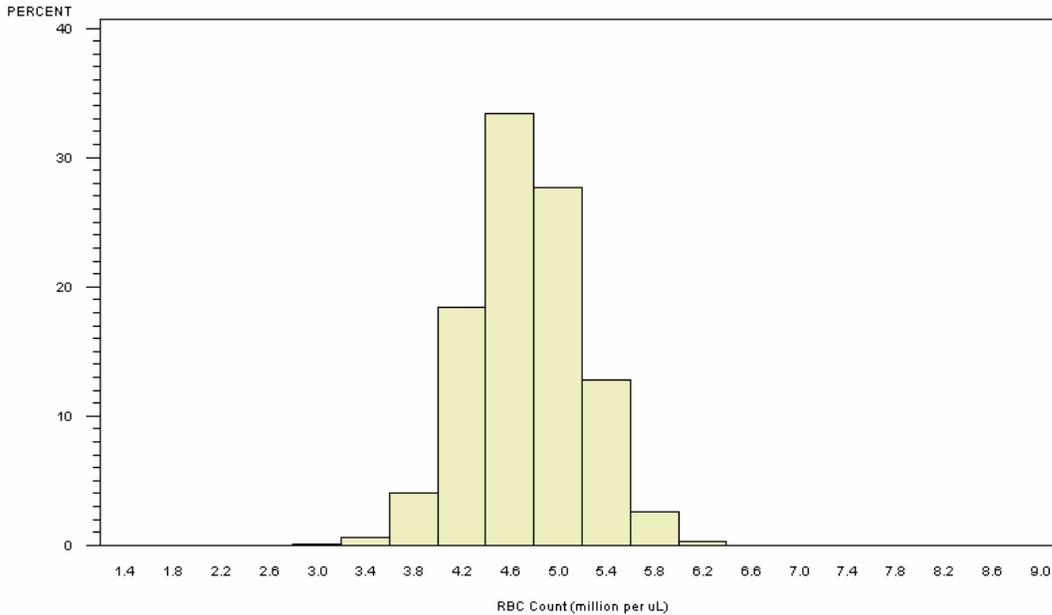

PARTICIPANTS=65877, MEAN=4.73, STANDARD DEVIATION=0.46

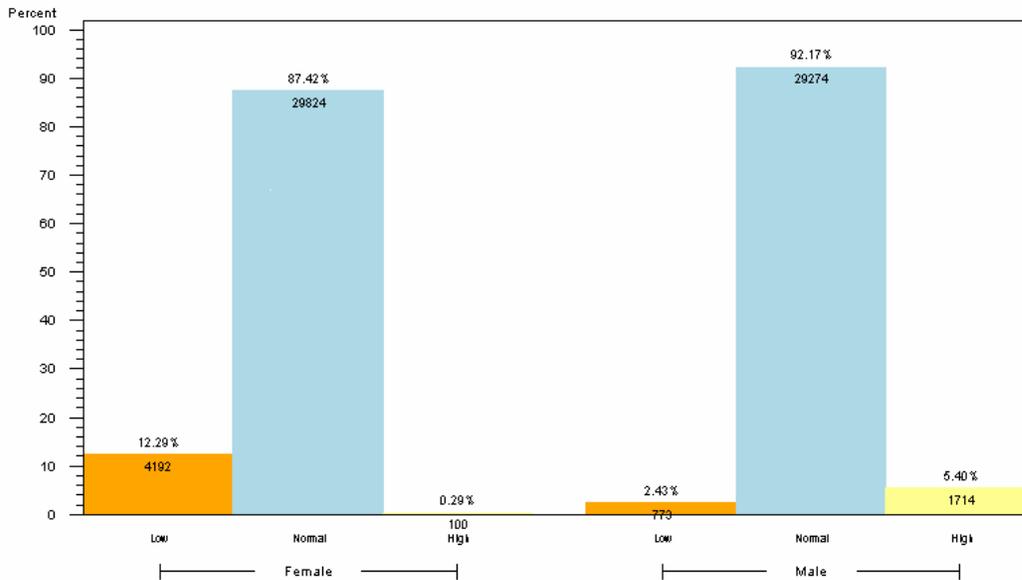
1st PERCENTILE=3.66, MEDIAN=4.72, 99th PERCENTILE=5.79

Reader's Guide to Understanding This Information:

Approximately 85% of females and 90% of males had normal RBC levels. A higher proportion of females compared to males had lower than expected RBC levels.
