

## SERUM AFP TUMOR MARKER IN CHILDREN AGED 1-2 YEARS


PARTICIPANTS=55, MEAN=4.69, STANDARD DEVIATION=2.36

### Reader's Guide to Understanding This Information:

Of the 55 participants 1-2 years of age with an AFP value reported, > 99% had AFP levels within the anticipated normal range.
