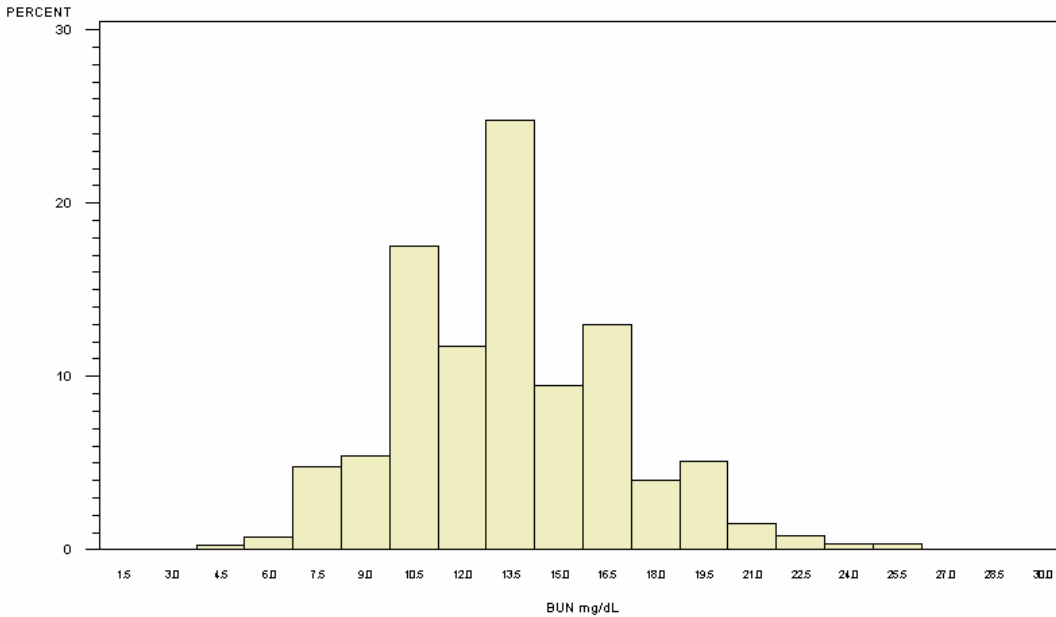


Summary Results for Blood Urea Nitrogen (BUN) for Participants < 12 Years of Age

PARTICIPANTS=4473, MEAN=13.49, STANDARD DEVIATION=3.44

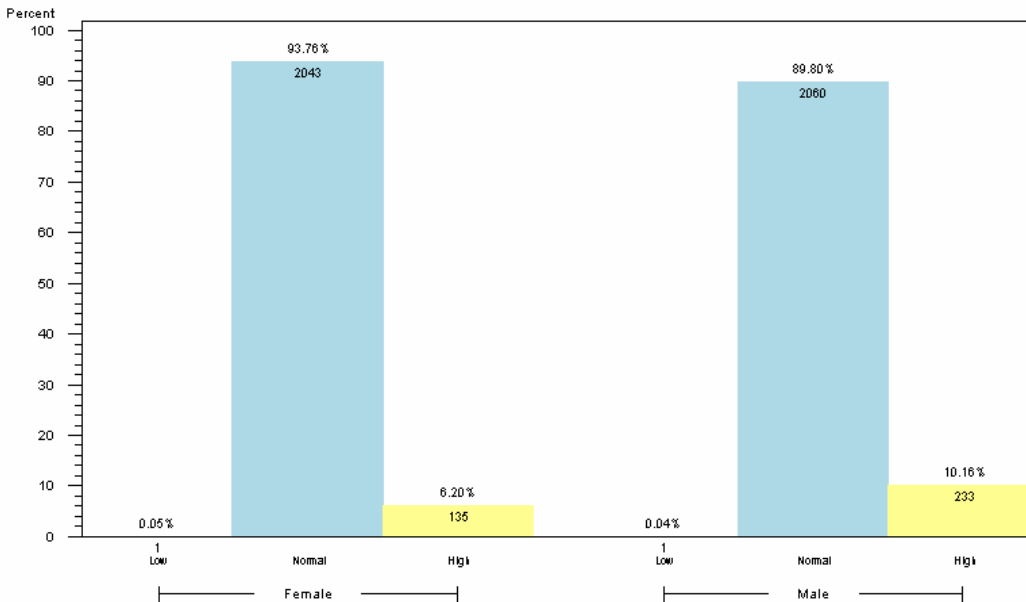
1st PERCENTILE=6.00, MEDIAN=13.00, 99th PERCENTILE=23.00

Reader's Guide to Understanding This Information:

Approximately 10% of participants <12 years of age had elevated levels of BUN. Slightly more boys than girls had abnormal BUN levels.
