

PARTICIPANTS=65878, MEAN=0.17, STANDARD DEVIATION=0.16



Reader's Guide to Understanding This Information:

Approximately 95% of all participants had absolute eosinophil counts within the expected range. Similar proportions of males and females (approximately 4%) had elevated absolute eosinophil counts.
