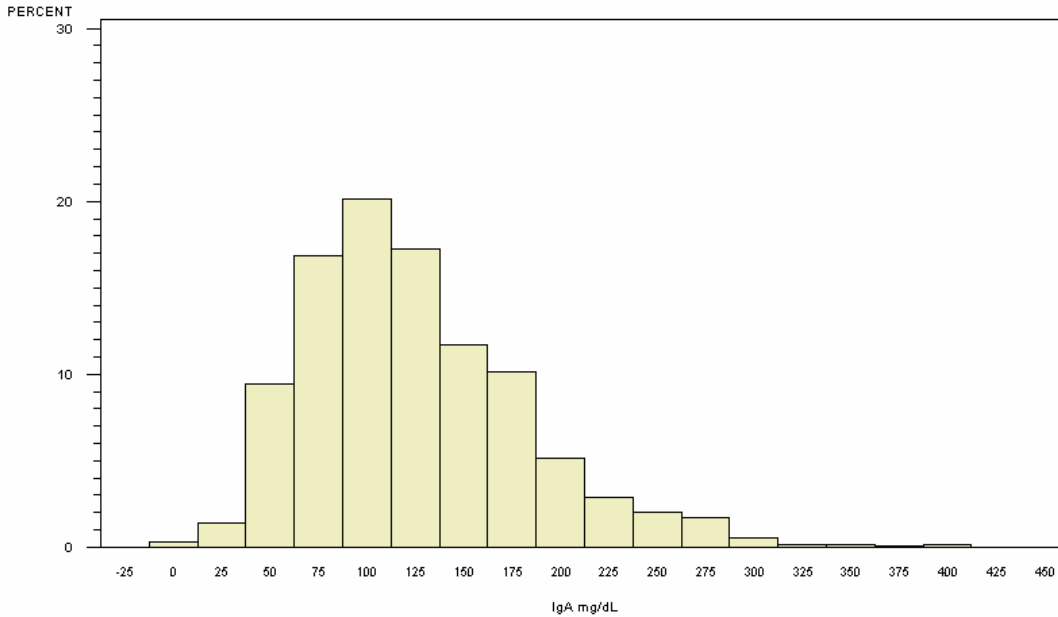

SERUM IMMUNOGLOBULIN A (IgA) IN ALL SUBJECTS AGED 7-9 YEARS

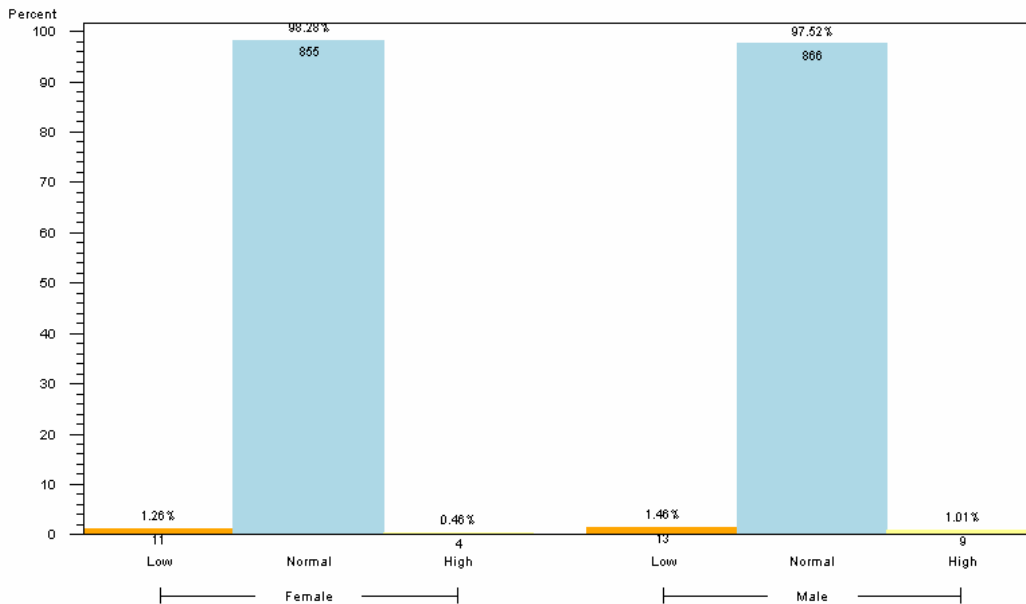
