


Summary Results for Absolute Lymphocytes for Participants 2-9 Years of Age

PARTICIPANTS=2928, MEAN=2.93, STANDARD DEVIATION=0.92


1st PERCENTILE=1.20, MEDIAN=2.80, 99th PERCENTILE=5.80
