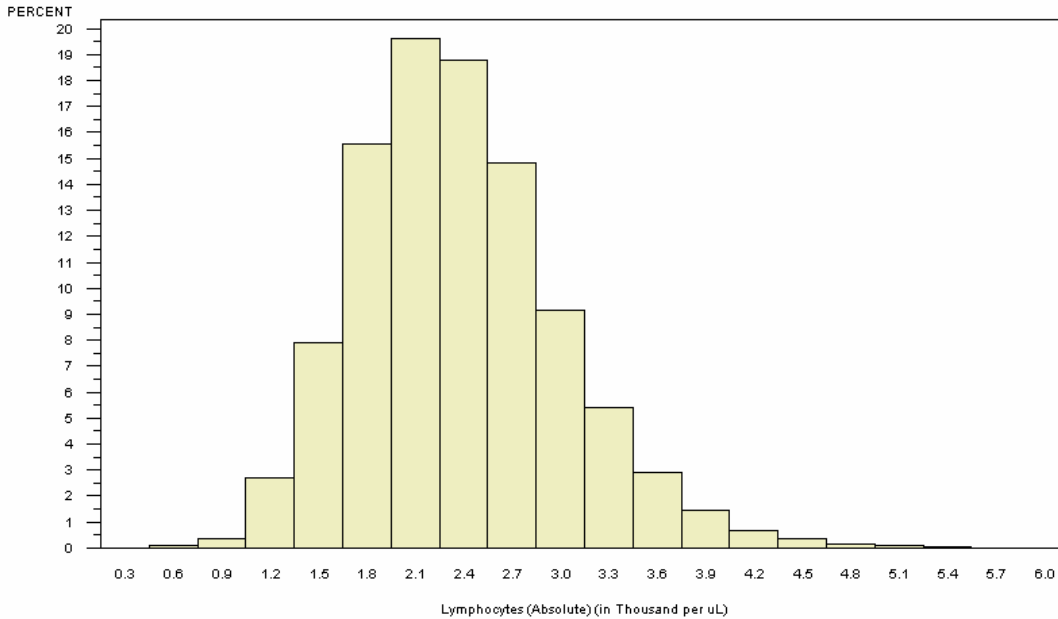


Summary Results for Absolute Lymphocytes for Participants 10-17 Years of Age

PARTICIPANTS=6941, MEAN=2.37, STANDARD DEVIATION=0.64

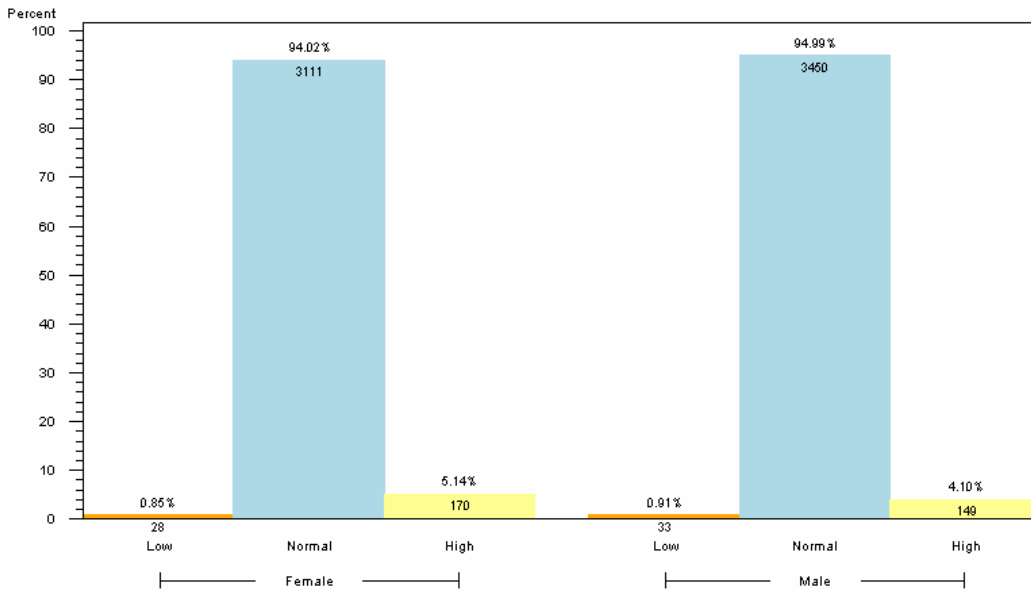
1st PERCENTILE=1.20, MEDIAN=2.30, 99th PERCENTILE=4.20
