ROSENBAUM FAMILY HOUSE PROVIDED HOSPITALITY TO NEARLY 2,000 GUESTS LAST YEAR

ROSENBAUM FAMILY HOUSE: The Rosenbaum Family House is a hospital hospitality house that offers meals, activities, a place to stay and pure comfort to those who have family members being treated at WVU Medicine in Morgantown, WV.

Opened in 1999, Rosenbaum Family House was made possible by the generosity of Hilda Rosenbaum. Because of her own difficult experiences during the hospitalizations of her children in other states, she was determined to see family members have an affordable and comfortable place to stay while supporting loved ones at WVU Medicine.

During the previous fiscal year, the Rosenbaum Family House hosted nearly 2,000 families, with over 1,500 of those families coming from West Virginia. The average length of stay at the Family House was 7 days.

Over 300 families took advantage of the Day Room, a room provided to families for shorter increments of time to simply take a nap or get a shower. Approximately 10,810 meals were provided to guests. Volunteers contributed nearly 2,000 hours of service.

Through the generous gifts of many individuals, businesses and organizations, the Rosenbaum Family House continues to provide comfort and support to adult outpatients and adult patients' families during a difficult time in their lives.

SISTERS HEALTH FOUNDATION SUPPORTING PUBLIC HEALTH COMMUNITY HEALTH INITIATIVE

PUBLIC HEALTH: Last year, Sisters Health Foundation of Parkersburg, West Virginia, provided \$35,000 to support the Integrated Community Engagement (ICE) Collaborative in Wood County, West Virginia, through the WVU School of Public Health. The funding is part of a two-year grant totaling \$70,000.

The goal of the ICE Collaborative is to create a culture of knowledge, support and community engagement for children.

Specifically, the project aims to tie the relationship between public health scholars, middle and high school leadership and faculty, and community members including parents, to work towards mutual health goals.

The partners are working to strengthen protective factors and decrease risk factors for drug use, teen parenting, and school drop-out in the lives of children and adolescents so they can have the opportunity to live productive, healthy, and successful lives.

The ICE Collaborative is co-led by Alfgeir Kristjansson, PhD, and Michael J. Mann, PhD, Assistant Professors in the Department of Social and Behavioral Sciences at the School of Public Health.

As the intervention arm of the School, the Department of Social and Behavioral Sciences works to improve health across the lifespan by uniting academic institutions and communities.

“We are so grateful for the support of Sisters Health Foundation,” said Dr. Kristjansson. “The ICE Collaborative is an example of the School of Public Health’s commitment to the future of health in West Virginia. We are grateful to the Sisters Health Foundation for joining us in the endeavor.”

The Sisters Health Foundation was established in 1996 and supports efforts that promote oral health, healthy lifestyles, and health equity in the Mid-Ohio Valley.

NURSING SCHOLARSHIP PROVIDES STUDENT, VETERAN OPPORTUNITY TO GRADUATE

Chris Vance is a veteran and second-career student currently enrolled in the WVU School of Nursing, working toward his bachelor of science degree.

Born and raised in Franklin, West Virginia, Chris made a decision to join the military following high school graduation, then moved to California where he received a degree in political science from the University of California. Once dreaming of becoming a lawyer, he decided to follow a different career path after spending some time in Iraq.

“I was in Iraq in 2003 with an artillery unit. There was this

little girl and this [explosive] severed both of her legs. We bandaged her up, but it was from that point on I knew I wanted to help people.”

Following his return from Iraq, Chris was accepted into the WVU School of Nursing. After exhausting his military-funded education assistance and in the prime of his nursing program, Chris was considering putting his 4.0 GPA and degree on hold to raise money in order to continue in the program.

But thanks to the Sue Ann and Raymond F. Morgan Nursing Scholarship, Vance was able to receive the financial assistance he needed to continue the nursing program, and will graduate next August with his bachelor’s degree.

“Without this scholarship, I don’t know if I’d be here. I’m definitely going to give back through scholarships after I graduate,” said Chris.

Both Sue Ann Morgan and her husband Raymond, who made the scholarship possible, are graduates from the WVU School of Nursing and School of Medicine, respectively. Chris is the first ever recipient of this scholarship, and hopes they continue it for other students like him in the future.

Following graduation, Chris plans on attending graduate school to become an acute care nurse practitioner where he hopes to continue making a difference in his patients’ lives.

“People can tell when you’re genuine,” mentioned Chris. “People can tell when you love what you do and it makes a big difference.”

GREENBRIER PHYSICIAN REMEMBERED THROUGH SCHOLARSHIP FOR MEDICAL STUDENTS

MEDICINE: Last year, a new scholarship was established for West Virginia students in the School of Medicine by the Brody Hazen Foundation, Inc. to support students from Greenbrier or nearby southern West Virginia counties.

The Brody Hazen Foundation donated approximately \$100,000 to endow the scholarship, which provided its first award for the 2015-2016 academic year.

The scholarship honors notorious West Virginia physician Dr. Arnold Brody, who practiced medicine for 44 years, many of which at The Greenbrier Clinic.

Dr. Brody was born and educated in Missouri, earning his MD degree from Washington University.

After his internship and residency in Florida, he spent five years in the Army, and then went on to practice medicine in California, Washington DC, Virginia, and Germany.

In 1956, Dr. Brody joined The Greenbrier Clinic in White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia. He was instrumental

in developing the Clinic's excellent reputation, through the diagnostic skills of carefully selected physicians. He built an enormous practice at The Greenbrier, and was loved by his employees, colleagues, and his many patients.

Dr. Brody passed away in 2015. His widow, Mrs. Lynne Brody, resides in Lewisburg, West Virginia.

The inaugural Dr. Arnold J. Brody Scholarship was awarded to Grant Langston, Class of 2017, who received the scholarship this year as well.

"This is my final year as a medical student and next year I will be entering residency," scholar Grant Langston said. "This scholarship has greatly reduced my burden of financial debt."

"I am so appreciative of the generous donors who helped to fund and establish the Arnold J. Brody Scholarship to support medical students like me," Grant Langston said. "This scholarship will greatly help me to become an emergency physician."

WESTFALL FAMILY ENDOWMENT ESTABLISHED BY TWO-TIME WVU DENTISTRY GRADUATE TO SUPPORT ORTHODONTICS AND ORAL & MAXILLOFACIAL SURGERY

DENTISTRY: School of Dentistry alumni have a strong sense of Mountaineer community—philanthropy supporting the future of the School and demonstrating pride and enthusiasm.

School of Dentistry alumnus Dr. Chad Westfall is just one example.

Dr. Chad Westfall has established a family endowment by pledging \$25,000 to the School of Dentistry. Dr. Westfall's new fund, the Westfall Family Dental Endowment, supports the Departments of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and Orthodontics.

"I completed a general practice residency at the WVU School of Dentistry in 2009 and worked closely with the oral surgery program," Dr. Westfall said. "My professor, Dr. Bryan Weaver, acted as a mentor to me during my residency, which greatly influenced my experience and time with the School."


Dr. Westfall is also a proud graduate of the WVU Orthodontics program and calls the department "one of the best in the country." He said Dr. Peter Ngan, chair, and Dr. Tim Tremont, clinical associate professor, are both taking the

program in the right direction.

"It is the support from alumni like Dr. Westfall that allow our School to keep moving in the right direction and lend support to our students, faculty, and patients," said Dean Anthony T. Borgia. "We are constantly striving to have WVU remain among the best dental schools in the country and appreciate any and all support from our alumni to maintain this level of excellence."

Dr. Westfall received his doctor of dental surgery degree in 2008, then completed a one-year general practice residency in 2009. He was awarded a masters in orthodontics in 2013.

Dr. Westfall currently has his own orthodontic practice in Abingdon, Virginia, where he resides with his wife,




L TO R: DR. BRYAN WEAVER, DR. CHAD WESTFALL, AND DR. PETER NGAN

HARLESS FOUNDATION OFFERS FIRST SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT SINCE PASSING OF WEST VIRGINIA BUSINESSMAN, PHILANTHROPIST JAMES “BUCK” HARLESS

CHARLESTON DIVISION: The late James Howard “Buck” Harless, a West Virginia native and lifelong resident, not only dedicated his life to thriving business ventures, but devoted his time to the community, West Virginia residents and other philanthropic projects throughout the Mountain State.

Graduating from Gilbert High School in 1937, Harless began working for local businessman George Crago who helped influence Harless’ entrepreneurial mindset, which eventually lead him to become successful in both the coal and timber industries.

A legendary success story, Harless made it a point to give back to his community and state. Because of his great passion for education and youth, he established the Larry Joe Harless Community Center and Clinic in Gilbert, honoring the dream

of his late son.

Harless recruited Drs. Jim and John Brick as visiting specialists at the clinic. These West Virginia University trained physicians dedicate their time and effort to ensure that southern West Virginians receive quality healthcare. In honor of Mr. Harless and his dreams of empowering rural communities, the Brick brothers continue to make monthly visits to the community clinic.

“Without the Bricks and Mr. Harless working together, I don’t think this (the clinic) would have been able to become what it is today,” observed Sharon Murphy, Executive Director of the James H. Harless Foundation.

In honor of James Harless and in recognition of the Brick brother’s commitment to provide healthcare in Southern West Virginia, the James H. Harless Foundation has pledged a total of \$50,000 to the West Virginia University School of Medicine, Charleston Division. The scholarship is designated for third and fourth year medical students intending to practice in southern West Virginia.

“The Foundation’s hope would be that a student from southern West Virginia would benefit from the scholarship and come back to southern West Virginia to practice medicine,” Murphy commented.

The endowed scholarship is the first major gift the James H. Harless Foundation has awarded since the passing of Mr. Harless in 2014. The first scholarship will be awarded in 2020.

PHARMACY: Providing students with the opportunity to thrive and receive a quality education is something our donors feel very strongly about. Suzanne and Timothy Fox feel no differently.

With scholarships being a top priority for the School of Pharmacy at West Virginia University, donors are appreciated more than ever before in giving students the opportunity and resources needed to succeed.

Both Suzanne and Tim are graduates of West Virginia University. As major supporters of West Virginia University and receiving a quality education, Suzanne and Tim established a scholarship to support pharmacy students. With a generous

donation from Suzanne and Tim, and a corporate match from Tim's company, T. Rowe Price Group, the result is a combined gift totaling \$25 thousand.

The Jack H. Smith Family Pharmacy Scholarship was established not only to honor Suzanne's father, but to assist a student who holds the same values as her father – generosity, community involvement, quality citizenship and an outstanding passion for receiving an education. Jack was a 1956 graduate from the West Virginia University School of Pharmacy,

and the endowed scholarship also honors Jack's father (Suzanne's grandfather) who was a pharmacist in Parkersburg, West Virginia.

"He would be very humbled. Education, Pharmacy, WVU – those were all things that were very important to Daddy," stated Suzanne in regards to how her father would feel about the establishment of the scholarship.

Being described as someone with a "million dollar smile" and a "great pharmacist with a charming attitude," the scholarship will be awarded to School of Pharmacy students who possess similar qualities to Jack, all while being engaged in the community and maintaining outstanding grades. While

preference will be given to West Virginia residents, the scholarship may be awarded to any student who fits the description.

Suzanne and Tim grew up in Fairmont, West Virginia, where Suzanne's father practiced as a pharmacist. Tim is a 1979 graduate from the College of Business and Economics. Suzanne is a 1981 School of Pharmacy graduate. Jack's wife, Mary Margaret (1955) and other daughter, Margaret Ellen (1983), both graduated from WVU with degrees in elementary education.

GRATEFUL EYE INSTITUTE PATIENT EMBODIES MOUNTAINEER SPIRIT

EYE INSTITUTE: Thelma Andy – now 89 years old – is an active member of the community and a beloved supporter of the Eye Institute at West Virginia University.

When Thelma was in her 70's, surgery was needed for cataracts in her eyes. Her first surgeries were not completed at the Eye Institute – and according to her, did not go well – which triggered a suggestion from her daughter to try the Eye Institute. Following her very successful surgeries with the Eye Institute and happiness because of this, a strong relationship was formed, which continues to this very day.

“I made up my mind it was time to do something for the Eye Institute,” stated Thelma, following the exceptional care she received.

As a result of her generosity, the Thelma W. Andy Support of Low Vision Program was started in 2004 in order to assist and provide support to other cases similar to her own, and to assist cases with greatest need.

“When I was a little girl, I was very poor,” mentioned Thelma. “If I ever have anything I can help somebody with, I will.”

HEALTH PLAN ORGANIZATION CONTINUES TO SUPPORT HEALTH SCIENCES STUDENTS WHO PLAN TO PRACTICE IN WEST VIRGINIA

MEDICINE AND NURSING: The Health Plan of the Upper Ohio Valley, a community-based health maintenance organization, continues to support the West Virginia University Health Sciences Center in its efforts to transform healthcare across the state through their support of scholarships for health professionals.

This year, The Health Plan provided scholarships covering tuition and fees for five West Virginia University medical students and three nursing students who intend to practice in West Virginia.

The Health Plan believes that a degree in the medical field should be attainable for everyone, said Jim Pennington, president and CEO of The Health Plan. “We felt this was a significant way for us to contribute to the well-being and welfare of the state and of West Virginians,” Pennington said.

As a breast cancer survivor herself, Betty was diagnosed at a point in which West Virginia did not have the resources needed to help her fight the disease. While being told she only had a few years to live, Betty decided that a few years just wasn't enough, and 30 years later, continues to celebrate her defeat of cancer every day. Throughout her treatment, Betty

imagined giving back to the community and offering a place where women like herself would be able to receive the highest quality of care close to home. In 1996, the Betty Puskar Breast Care Center opened, providing the best available expertise and the most advanced technology for early detection and successful treatment of breast cancer.

Betty's philanthropic support of nearly 30 years is a tribute to her deep commitment to excellence and care for others. Her contributions to the WVU Cancer Institute for 2016 alone totaled more than \$23 thousand. Betty not only dedicates her time to serving women throughout West Virginia, but as a passionate and beloved member of the Morgantown community. Betty Puskar serves on the Leadership Council for the Mary Babb Randolph Cancer Center and was recognized as the Most Loyal West Virginian in 2006.

ALUMNI COUPLE ESTABLISHES NEW SCHOLARSHIP FOR PHARM.D. AND MBA STUDENTS

PHARMACY: Both the School of Pharmacy at West Virginia University and its donors are focused heavily on education, and providing students with the tools needed to succeed.

Being passionate about education, as well as the professions of business and pharmacy, Tim Whitten and his wife Mary have established a scholarship to assist students pursuing a dual PharmD and MBA degree.

First established in 2016, the Whitten Family Scholarship will assist School of Pharmacy PharmD and MBA dual-degree students in continuing their education, pursuing careers similar to the career path that Tim has had with various pharmacy and business ventures.

“Obviously we hope it means a little less debt for the student recipients,” said Tim regarding the scholarship. “We really like the new dual PharmD and MBA degree that WVU offers. Combining science and business will provide WVU students a fairly unique and versatile skill set right out of school that can be applied in a variety of health-related industries.”

Tim grew up in Beckley, West Virginia

and Mary grew up in New Jersey, then both attended West Virginia University upon graduating from high school. Mary graduated in 1980 with an agriculture and forestry degree, and Tim in 1979 from the School of Pharmacy.

Now serving as the Chief Commercial Officer for Taiho Oncology, Inc., Tim believes “the program will open a broad range of opportunities for students, including in the biotech and pharmaceutical industries” where he’s spent a large majority of his career.

Tim was the first in his family to graduate from high school and attend college – which he says changed his life “in many positive ways” – and Mary started a trend within her family, leading her brother and sister to attend WVU as well.

“The importance of WVU really runs through our families,” said Tim regarding why the scholarship was established. The scholarship, in essence, also recognizes Tim’s parents, who he said valued education very highly, and regularly stressed the importance of

THE GIFT OF LIFE-CHANGING DENTAL CARE

DENTISTRY: It's the gift that keeps on giving.

Dr. David Whiston ('65 DDS), a WVU graduate and past president of the American Dental Association and ADA Foundation, wanted a way to give back to his alma mater and improve the health of West Virginians.

Enter the David and Julia Whiston Oral Healthcare Fund.

Three years later, the fund set up by Whiston and his wife Julia, executive director of the White House Correspondents' Association, continues to

provide dental care – often life changing – for patients at Milan Puskar Health Right in Morgantown.

“It's a great way to help those in need, while at the same time giving to a great school that's helped all of us,” David Whiston said.

Health Right is a primary care clinic that partners with the WVU dental clinics and private practices to offer medical care at no cost to uninsured or underinsured, low-income residents in north-central West Virginia. Patients come from as far away as the northern panhandle because they've run

out of options.

The need is great, Health Right Executive Director Laura Jones said. There are hundreds on the waiting list, and many lack the most basic of dental care such as fillings or extractions.

“We served about 300 individuals last year in some capacity whether it was through referrals to the School of Dentistry or private dentists – or through dental hygiene,” she said.

Health Right officials said the experience of receiving dental care can transform lives. They recalled one man early on in

the program who met with one of the social workers. He wouldn't look up, but once he got his dentures, he made eye contact with people whenever he came in, and it made a positive difference in his overall wellness.

The Whistons recently made another contribution to the Oral Healthcare Fund. School of Dentistry Dean Anthony T. Borgia sees it as a win-win for the School and Health Right. The School is able to offer students valuable hands-on experience with challenging cases, while patients receive care that can improve their quality of life.

DENTAL IMPLANT COMPANY SUPPORTS RESIDENT EDUCATION AND TRAINING

DENTISTRY: Straumann USA, an international dental implant company, is supporting the West Virginia University School of Dentistry in its efforts to enhance dental implant education and training opportunities. Straumann has provided School of Dentistry residents the opportunity to broaden their education by awarding two grants of \$40,000 each, specifically for the field of dental implant education.

Prosthodontists, dentists specializing in cosmetic dental surgery and repair, are few and far between in West Virginia, making it difficult for WVU dental residents to learn about the specialty. “Through the generosity of Straumann we have been afforded the opportunity of not only enhancing the education of our dental residents but improving their ability to provide

state-of-the-art care to the people of West Virginia,” said Matthew Bryington, Assistant Professor and Assistant Director of Graduate Prosthodontics for the School of Dentistry.

First awarded in 2014, the grants provided eight residents the opportunity to attend conferences and sessions to expand their education, including the American College of Prosthodontists Annual Sessions and the Academy of Osseointegration Annual Sessions. Through these educational opportunities, dental residents have not only been awarded the chance to enhance their education, but enhance the lives of so many West Virginians in need of specialty dental work.

DEPARTMENT OF OTOLARYNGOLOGY ENHANCED BY GIFTS THAT RECOGNIZE PASSION AND LEADERSHIP OF LONGTIME FACULTY MEMBER DR. HASSAN RAMADAN

MEDICINE: Longtime faculty member Hassan H. Ramadan, MD, MSc, was named chair of the Department of Otolaryngology in June 2015, after 24 years with the WVU School of Medicine. Known for his excellent care of patients and his advancements in research and clinical practice, Dr. Ramadan is well respected by his peers and residents who came together in 2015 to establish a fund to honor him.

To recognize Dr. Ramadan's passion and leadership, the group established the Hassan Ramadan Otolaryngology Resident Enrichment and Alumni Engagement Fund to enhance the educational and professional development of residents and to strengthen alumni engagement activities. Dr. Ramadan serves as director of the Department of Otolaryngology's residency program.

WVU otolaryngology residents Jonathan Wu, MD, Marcus Shaffer, MD, Justin Douglas, MD, Matthew Oliverio, MD, and otolaryngology professor Ron Wilkinson, MD were inaugural contributors. Within a few months, the fund made a positive impact by enabling the department to host educational opportunities for residents, incentivize them to submit papers and posters and enable them to attend and present at national conferences.

Filling a need for additional resident support due to reductions in federal, state and other funding sources, the Ramadan Fund will continue to improve the educational experiences of residents and support a bright future for the program.

Dr. Douglas, a 2008 School of Medicine graduate and former WVU otolaryngology resident said on behalf of the inaugural donor group, "We feel that we have one of the best otolaryngology programs in the country, and we are extremely proud of that, but it often takes significant resources to support our residents and honor our alumni. We established this fund so that no matter the future direction of our program, we can always have the resources to honor those that have built the program and support those that are currently participating in it."

Dr. Ramadan specializes in pediatric otolaryngology, which includes ear, nose and throat diseases in children and nasal and sinus diseases.



Dr. Saul performed the first radiofrequency catheter ablation for Wolff-Parkinson-White syndrome in a child, as well as the first catheter


